Membership: Dick Allen

A request by **Ron Breslawski** to purchase a Membership Certificate for his son, Junior Member **Ed Breslawski** was tentatively approved at the previous Board meeting, but requires approval of the members present, per **Article 2**; **Membership**; **Section 9 (C) Certificates**. Ron's request was approved by unanimous voice vote.

Building & Grounds: Jim Rabjohn

Jim temporarily lost his credentials as **Sheriff of North Star**, when he could not produce his badge to the officers or members. Fortunately, it was found by a seeing eye dog, who returned it to the proper authorities. The President placed the Sheriff on 6 months probation with a warning to take his responsibility as Security Officer more seriously. Otherwise, there was nothing serious to report.

Treasurer's Report: Nick Hardie

December Transactions dated 2/3/2011 showed Income of \$5,646.00 and Expenses of \$7,130.14. The New Years Day Shoot showed gross income of \$3.497.00 less expenses of approx. \$850.00 and excluding targets. Other notable income items were *NewsNotes* ads from **Beikirch Ammunition**, **McCann Insurance** and another \$200.00 donation from **Kurt Brinkman** in support of youngsters to attend the DEC Conservation Education Camp at Rushford.

Mon. Cty. Cons. Council: Chris Wiest

The MCCC plans to submit a resolution via the NYSCC demanding that Conservation Fund \$\$\$ (your license fees, excise taxes on guns & fishing tackle, etc.) be earmarked exclusively for traditional uses, **NOT** for the general fund. This should be a serious concern to all members. It is important to stay informed on issues. There is \$23M of your dollars that the lawmakers in Albany would love to grab.

Winter Offhand Rifle League

Frank Petricone reported that he has had almost 20 members sign up for this competition. Due to the lousy weather in January, he is extending the deadline for completing the required targets. He will contact delinquent shooters via e-mail so no one is overlooked. Al Rice commented that **EXCELLENT** coaching was available for novice rifle shooters.

On the same topic, **Curt Drewell** reminded members that the **Rifle clinic** will follow shortly after the completion of the Winter League in April. Application forms will be available in the clubhouse or by contacting Curt at 746-9435.

Litigation Committee: Greg Beyler

The committee has compiled a list of almost 20 questions for possible legal counsel. Pete was given approval to discuss them with possible legal representative(s) and review options with the Board at their next meeting. He was also authorized to share copies of the Constitution, Ground Rules, by-Laws and any Documents of Incorporation to begin the process.

New/Old Business
