Membership: Ron Breslawski. Welcome two of our new members present at tonight's meeting: Dale Cummings and Tom Buss. Welcome gentlemen! #### **Building and Grounds: Jim Rabjohn**

Roadway stone: Jim can level a good part of the road with our york rake, but we'll need several loads of stone to fill in the rough spots and keep the mud down. He estimates no more than \$2500 for 6 loads of stone. Motion made & seconded. It passed unanimously.

The club's tractor is leaking oil from the left front. Several of our crack mechanics have looked and are not sure where the leak is coming from. Jim recommended having the local Deere dealer take a look. Pickup Monday, and return later that week. We don't have a dollar estimate yet, but the membership present recognizes the need for that equipment and unanimously agreed to go forward with the repair.

Sagging Chalet floor: JR reported that **Glen Reed** has agreed to examine the understructure and will recommend a path forward to sure up the chalet floor. Thanks Glen.

There are a few ash trees that need some attention (chain saw). Please contact Sheriff Rabjohn if you can help clear some of them.

New Business: Budget items due to BOD in May

Non-resident concealed carry permits: We have a possibility of getting a multistate handgun permit course given at North Star. Two options exist: Utah only or Utah + Florida. Utah non-resident permit provides reciprocity with over 30 states including neighboring PA, OH, and VT. Florida adds a couple other states (Florida and NM, as examples). Please do not use NewsNotes as an authority on concealed carry permits. Do your own research. Pete McCann will solicit input on interest to see if enough members / others would be attendees of such a class. Note: the cost is not exactly known, but likely to be around \$100 (more for both states).

Water heater: The many year old on-demand electric water heater in the club house is on its last leg and we need a replacement. Alternatives discussed include tank or tankless, propane or electric. Size/Capacity of each option is another consideration. Dan Sperr volunteered to talk with Dave Isaac to get a recommendation to bring to the BOD for the May meeting.

**Gift to North Star**: A large wooden North Star sign has been presented to North Star by an anonymous donor. **Dan Sperr** will find a suitable location of prominence to display the sign. Thanks Dan and our secret benefactor.
