Income for August - \$6,192 Expenses for August - \$4,552.53 August Net Balance: \$1,639.47

Major items of income were new membership dues; black box (\$1,452); ten stand (\$942) and a donation. Major items of expense were new water heater (\$1,450); second payment on preserve birds (\$1,750).

Nick brought up doing a 'pre-buy' on Propane for the upcoming winter, like we did last year. Last year we purchased 730 gallons and didn't make it through the winter. Motion was made and accepted/approved by the members present, to pre-buy 700 gallons propane @ \$1.99/ gallon through Hometowne Energy.

The motion was discussed ... there might be two extra traps in the Ten Stand area that can be used instead of purchasing new; so this will be researched further. Dan Sperr will talk with Jay Giese and a few others in charge of the ranges at the club about this.

The Ten Stand needs some minor repairs and to be stained. Talk with Jim Rabjohn or Jay Giese if you are interested in helping with this.

The Boyscout Ash tree out back came down. Thank you to Jim Priestly and Mike Kirchgessner for cleaning this up!

We received a large shipment of clay targets. **THANK YOU to Al Rice, Ron Breslawski, Rich Breslawski, Ed Breslawski and Nick Hardie** for unloading all of these off the trucks, labelling all stacking in the barn.

The clay targets should stay in the barn. The change in weather is not good for them, so they are best stored in the barn. Only a few boxes at a time will be stored in the chalet, for events, such as Hunters Tour, and as extra.

North Star has purchased a crossbow target and it should be in place on the archery range already. It is labeled for crossbow use. Crossbow shooters should not use the regular targets or the 3D targets because they are not made for crossbows and will be ruined.
