Treasurer's Report: Harry Reiter (welcome back,

Harry wasn't able to get to the black box before this meeting, to report on income there. This income will be reported at the next general member meeting. Major items of expense were reimbursements to our snowplowers; start up money for Hunters Tour; payment on the JD mower; electric, lights, propane and water bills. Jim Rabjohn purchased 15 bails of hay for the Sporting clays course, for Hunters Tour – cost was \$45. NorthStar is owed a \$100 refund on 11 birds for the Preserve, from last year.

The Board of Directors approved Harry Reiter to purchase 500 checks for NorthStar / spend up to \$150, so we can continue to do business!

On behalf of NorthStar, the Board of Directors approved payments/donations to Mercy Flight for \$25, and to the Hamlin Volunteer Ambulance core for \$25.

NorthStar received in monetary donations, in memory of Dick Groves' wife, Leslie, who passed away in March. Thank you to all who donated. We think this money would best be used towards Camp Rushford camper fees; we think Dick would agree with that.

Treasurer's Report: Harry Reiter

As of May 7: Income \$5,437 Expenses \$5,418

Major items of income were the Hunters Tour (\$3,004); kitchen; and black box.

Major items of expense were Hunters Tour food, parts for traps, stone for driveway.

Hunters Tour net was \$1,456. We saw 158 total shooters come through; 114 league shooters; 44 practice.

Pete mentioned annual Dues. The letters will be going out shortly. We had to wait to calculate all the work hours, for the year, which had to be in by April 30. Annual Dues are really due on May 1st each year; but you have until June 30 to pay. If you are not paid by this time, the Board of Directors will take action. The ranges look good. Frank dumped all of the shell barrels after/ during the Hunters Tour.

These were full, including trash in them. If you can (help) empty these barrels before they are half full, they are easier to handle/ easier to empty! They can be emptied in to the dumpster in the parking lot.

The Tote/ bin in the Chalet is for Cardboard ONLY; no trash! There are trash cans around club property for trash.

The other Tote/ bin for cardboard only will be located in the big shed.

At the Rifle range, some boards are shot up bad. For turkey loads ... use on the cardboard only, not the plywood; as it will ruin the plywood. It is easier to replace the cardboard.

Take out your trash and cigarette butts when you are done shooting, to keep the ranges clean.

The 'bone yard' needs some attention. It should be inventoried, to decide what to do with some of the old manual traps, etc. out there; sell them?
