Treasurer's Report: Harry Reiter

Major items of income were black box. Major items of expense were payment for the road drainage project; 2nd installment payment for the Kubota tractor.

Ranges/ Buildings and Grounds: Pete McCann and Greg Beyler

The Ditch/ Culvert project is complete! We will have to see how it works ... how well it drains.

One member reported he came out to shoot on the clays course ... he found traps covered improperly, exposed to the weather; and not disarmed ... cocked and ready to shoot – being a huge safety hazard! **Once again ... be reminded** to please take the time to use the nice trap covers we have now to keep our traps in good working order; AND please disarm the traps when you are done. One of these times someone really will get hurt!

One member noticed there is a large limb on the Maple tree, hanging over the clubhouse, that potentially could come down (with wind, snow, ice) and damage our building. This will be addressed and trimmed.

We will not be using our large gasoline tank any more. There now are only two pieces of club owned equipment that use gas. To have gas available in our tank, we would have to purchase a minimum of 150 gallons; we would not use that much over a long period of time; the gas would get old. It has been proposed to purchase a fireproof safe to keep approx. four (4), 5 gallon cans of gasoline in. At this meeting, a Motion was made to purchase a fireproof safe (one has been identified), for this purpose. This was accepted by all members at this meeting.

Preserve Report: Dave Isaac

Letters and dues notices have been sent out to this year's Preserve members. Anyone interested in joining the Preserve group, you can contact Dave Isaac or a BOD member. There are still spots open. The first bird delivery will be September 18. Be mindful that the Preserve 'season' runs from around Sept. 18 through early February (Super Bowl Sunday!). Members will be on club property to release and shoot their birds.
