The clays course has been cleaned up – brush picked up; split some wood. There is more wood to be split; if you have a wood splitter and can help with this. This wood belongs to the club, so needs to stay on property. Batteries were swapped out on some of the trap machines, so they are ready to go for Hunters Tour.

If you are shooting the clays course and see that a trap will go under water, due to all the rain lately/ weather in general, please make note of what station and report it to Frank; so he can move it; so we don't lose a trap machine to water!

Reminder ... please take your trash out with you/ clean up after yourselves, so someone else doesn't have to!

The low and high Skeet houses will need to be re-skinned in the Spring. Any skilled carpenters would be welcome to help us out with this project! Please consider this for your Spring schedule.

Reminder ... when you restock the traps ... (thank you for re-stocking!) but please put the proper birds in to the proper traps. The Skeet and Ten Stand take the 'non-bio' birds; the other trap machines use the 'bio' birds.

Totes for the traps ... Frank still needs some help/ a work crew, to get these sorted – different sizes for the different size traps-; put handles on them; get them fitted to the machines. Power tools are needed; Frank has some. We would like to get this done before the snow flies, to keep the trap machines out of the weather.

IF you volunteer to help with this project, wear old clothes that you should plan on tossing after the work is done! The totes have remnants of stain on them; the stain should not be put in your washing machine; can't be washed out.
