Anyone can operate the Ten Stand. If you are not comfortable with any aspect of that, you can contact Frank for a training session. Up top ... if you are not comfortable going up there; you can shoot from down below.

There are 3 switches in the grey box, under the 10 Stand main structure to power up some of the machines. The other machines are battery operated. Station 9 is a new machine; that trap is operational.

Ranges – please don't shoot Turkey loads at the back boards; they damage and destroy the boards. Bring your own backboards/ targets if you would please! Thank you!

No outhouse out back any more ... it has been decommissioned! Use the woods ... bring your own biodegradable tp. Watch out for poison ivy!

We continue to have a septic system issue. This has been identified and is in the stages of being decided how best to fix for now. THANK YOU Mike Kirchgessner and Dakota Castrechino for doing the legwork on this; looking in to the issues; getting pricing and giving expert opinions. There is still more work to be done before we can fix this.

Please be mindful when using the toilets in the club house. They are ok to use ... just be nice to them.

SCOPE/Monroe Co Conservation: Chris Wiest

There was a Crossbow bill out there; fell off for now. Right now the focus is on covid, but some things still moving.

A bill has been introduced that would require anyone purchasing a gun to take a mental health test. The Jr. Hunter law passed. Now kids 12 years old can hunt; BUT counties have to Opt in... each county will decide whether to support this new law; you have to check with your county before taking your 12 year old hunting.

At the National level ... will pick up the 2nd Amendment. A bill out there ... you have to show 'cause' when applying for a gun permit now.

The Conservation Council will host the Youth Fishing day ... June 5, 8-10 am; at Powder Mill Park.

June 22, 7:00 pm - SCOPE will host a talk with Sheriff Baxter; Adam Bello and Jamie Romeo at the Elks Club, 3525 East Henrietta Road. Come out; show up ... to show you care about what is happening with gun laws!

June 27, 7 pm - Dr. Paul Maurer is scheduled to speak at the Elks Club, 3525 East Henrietta Road. There is no fee to attend. Dr. Maurer is a specialist in ballistics. He will talk about 'where to shoot to kill'; among other things. This one should be interesting!!

This year there are no DEC camp programs, due to Covid. Hopefully next year, 2022, camps will be back. Registration typically begins in January, 2022, if there will be camp next year.
