**Membership:** three new members visited. John Billings, Chris Griggs, Frank "Sonny" Sassone. Dave Scorse made a motion to accept all three, Ron second, approved. Welcome! Also, Craig Almeter applied for life membership, Ron made motion to approve application, Al 2<sup>nd</sup>, approved

**Treasurer report:** Harry - monthly income \$3313, expenses \$2470.91, see Harry's report for further. End of fiscal year balance was \$77,037.63. Reserve fund entering FY 22-23 is \$50,690.52. Only three members left that haven't paid dues for the year. Harry reached two who promised to pay. One is unreachable.

**Building/grounds:** Frank: Will be ordering new clay birds. Harry has already designated funds for them. No new reports/complaints of broken equipment.

Frank repainted the Shady range shed. Someone had been shooting from the road and using paintball gear. Nick received a response to his email from a member who shot from the road and used paintball gear. They discussed the issues, and the member will stop.

Frank has not received many requests to learn the new Ranger side by side operation.

Skeet range high house had a large hornet's nest in the overhang. Has been taken care of. There are cans of hornet killer left in both houses on the skeet range. Please pick up shells and cardboard and remove them from the range. Please don't leave them in the buckets.

The next 10 stand shoots are July 28, August 11, and 25. Frank is already rotating batteries on the sporting clays course to get ready for member appreciation. Tim has already repaired the malfunctioning trap out there.

The Trap range is operational. Contact Frank if you want to learn how to run the machine.

**Rifle range:** Please remove trash from the range as the barrels get full. Clean up and remove your own paper targets.

The first company would need to be re-bid as the first expired.
