Secretary report – Dan Carlson

Treasurer Report: Harry Reiter- All dues are paid. Report attached.

Membership report – Ron Breslawski– no new report New member orientation – Nick mentioned potential inconsistencies in the orientation points. Can we create a checklist for bullet points to be certain to cover during orientation? Also, discussed potentially creating a checklist/handout for new members.

Nick also wanted to be sure to recognize previous board members like Christine Grove, for her 12 years as Secretary and Ed Breslawski, who is still helping with membership tasks. **Buildings and Grounds** – Frank Petricone -

Road is very dusty. Please be careful to follow the posted speed limit.

Need help with weed whacking around the clays course. It's tough to mow out there if we can't see the cables. Frank is working to add a rabbit to the 10-stand.

Need an archery course lead person. Someone to inventory the different targets and place new targets on the range.

Upcoming ten stand shoots: August 25^{th,} September 8 and 22, October 13 and 27.

Skeet/sporting clays – bees/hornets have been taken care of.

Trap – hasn't seemed to be much interest. Nobody has contacted Frank to learn how to run the machine.

Rifle/Shady ranges – seemed to be working well. They are being looked after.

Sporting clays – We are hosting Hunter's Tour on November 4 and 5. Need a work party in October to reset all the traps and machines around the course.

One safety concern – the shrubs and bushes out at the road make it hard to see when leaving the club driveway. It's a state road. Can someone knock the bushes down safely?

Nick added -Frank P. and Mike Kirchgessner graded the driveway. Thank you!

Club security/entry system. Tim has been talking to different vendors to look at the current system. Tim and Nick are working to schedule an estimate.

Nick wanted to recognize Jim Aiello. He has been doing a great job of keeping the club house clean. Thanks, Jim! Old Business – Constitution – Nick received two "Nice jobs" and one person who struggled to open the link. Vote to take place in December. Dom took a few minutes to explain the difference between constitution and by-laws. He used the example of changing the prices on the shooting courses. The board can do that without the members' consent, but it makes great sense to continue bringing those decisions to the membership. Dom was very complimentary of the process the board has undertaken.

At the next general meeting we will bring up the constitution and vote in December. Encourage people to look at it and ask for copies if they cannot access the website.

Liability waivers – be sure to get them signed from visitors.

Dead trees along the roadway. Makes sense to have a big work party, close the road, and drop them on the road. Would it be worth it to rent a big woodchipper? We could use the chips to line the sporting clays course. Mike Menear and help disassembled and removed Lawler's tower. The project is complete.

10-stand tower: Al Castrechino started a discussion regarding loose floor boards on the second tier of the 10-stand. Discussion involved; replacing all the wood on the 2nd tier or just doing piece by piece as needed. Al will look at the entire project and report back in with the reasonable options. **Until repairs can be addressed, the top level of the 10 Stand will be shut down effective immediately.**

Bldg. and Grounds – Frank Petricone – Watch for ground bees near the stump adjacent to the driveway. If you know of any issues or problems, please let Frank P know.

Archery – Animal targets have been set up. Please don't shoot crossbow bolts at the archery targets.

10 Stand – Sept. 8 and 22 are the upcoming shoots. The top level is currently closed for floor repairs. October 13 and 27 are trap shooting nights. It is suggested to use modified or improved modified chokes. Come early to learn how to set the trap.

Skeet Range – Please do your best to clean up after yourself. Please empty the buckets and discard or remove your empty shells.

Sporting Clays Course – Needs some weed whacking before the next hunter's tour. Watch for poison ivy. Hunter's tour here November 5 & 6. Will need a work detail prior. Dates TBD. A machine was damaged on the course due to negligence. It will require several hours of repair. Please close down the machines properly. If you aren't sure what to do, please ask!

Shady Range – Please pick up your brass and trash.

Rifle Range – Please do your best to sweep up your .22 brass. Is it OK to shoot a spinner target? (question to Nick H from a member). Yes, so long as it's manufactured for that use – not homemade. Please push steel targets up close to one of the berms.
