Preserve Report – Dave Isaac - 12 members have paid ahead for the year. Discussion came up about hunting pheasants on club property during deer season. Call to Order – Nick H. 7:02pm

Secretary's Report – Dan Carlson Sequence - News Notes will now go out after the BOD meeting instead of after the general meeting. The idea is that members will be able to see what's going on at the BOD level prior to the general meeting. Members could be more prepared. Good suggestion from one of our members.

**Treasurer's Report** – **Harry Reiter** – Income - \$0 (so far in October), Expenses \$943.77. See Harry's report.

**Membership Report** – Ron Breslawski. No New members.

Orientation Checklist – Ron handed out a checklist. Typically, Ron, Nick or Tim Daily all do orientation. Discussion was held to standardize the process. BOD members were encouraged to read the list and make suggestions for additions/improvements. Example: Harry noticed that there was a limit to a member hosting two guests. This only applies to one guest per member for hunting.

Tom Rohr would like to resign his membership. He will be doing quite a bit of travelling and is not using the club.

Craig Almeter submitted his application for life membership. Motion made, seconded, approved by vote.

Paul Russo submitted his application for life membership. Motion made, seconded, and approved by vote.

**Buildings, Grounds, and Equipment** – **Frank Petricone** Someone has been shooting #4 Steel loads on the sporting clays course. Trying to track down who it is. Members are responsible for their guests and their ammo, too. Please only shoot the types of ammo listed on each course.

The snowblower attachment has been put on the tractor.

The "check belt" light is on, on the Kawasaki ATV. Is there anyone who can service it? Otherwise, it will have to go to Spencerport for service. It is currently still operational but needs to be addressed.

Limbs and branches have been taken down around the grounds. The trails have been cleared and improved. Two weeks until the next Hunter's Tour. Thanks to the folks who showed up for the work detail on 10/15.

#### **Ranges** - Frank Petricone

**Archery** – Please take some time to pick up branches and twigs as you walk around the range. Al Castrechino will talk to Mike Kirchgessner about removing the 3-D targets this week or at least before the ground freezes. Archery season is well underway.

**Ten Stand** – The tower machine is shut down. Please do not go up on the 2<sup>nd</sup> deck. Work is underway to shore up the structure. Dave Scorse brought a sample of U-shaped steel pieces (Uni-strut) to provide cross bracing to support the structure. He will price out the costs. Doug Baker brought a proposal to shore it up using steel cables and turn buckles. Doug's estimate is about \$225. Dave is going to price out the steel and compare estimates.

**Skeet Range** – No updates

**Sporting Clays Course** - Updated for Tour, Frank is topping off all the batteries. Be sure to turn the power off when you are done. Instructions have been attached to all the machines.

**Trap range** – Operational. One more trap shoot scheduled for 10/27.

**Rifle Range** – Please pick up after yourself. Even your .22 brass!

**Shady Range** – Lots of mice in the Shady range shed. Frank has been placing repellent in the shed. If you see mice building a nest, please remove it.

Club Safety and Security – Nick Hardie. Clubhouse entry system completed – The new system has been installed. Please report any issues to Nick. If you have trouble opening the door, push in first before you pull it open. When you close it. Please press on the door from the outside to make sure it's closed.

Preserve – Dave Issac – Ban on Pheasant Hunting during gun season. Dave brought up the issue at the last general meeting. No one seems to know where the general rule came from. Was it just an old gentlemen's agreement? Discussion was held about times and dates. Dave brought a spreadsheet showing the numbers of members on property during hunting season for the last two years. Rarely were there more than 2 per day. If you are hunting on club property during the regular season for deer. Please be sure to wear orange as required. Please place your location on the sign in sheet. Be aware, pheasant hunting, and deer hunting might occur at the same time.
