General Meeting April 6, 2023

Call to Order Nick H. 7:30 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance Nick

Guests: None

Secretary's Report – Dan Carlson - No report

Treasurer's Report – Harry Reiter – See Harry's Report March Income: \$3821.59. Expenses: \$13,499.50. Big expense for the month was \$11,108 was for new trap machines and remotes. Motion made to accept. 2nd, passed by votes.

Harry also prepared a separate break down report for the St Patty's Day shoot. \$2759 total income, \$1,734.25 net.

Also, Harry presented a budget proposal for the Fiscal Year 2023 – 24 budget of \$57,450. He estimated a \$3500 increase due to inflation as seen in recent trends. Harry had prepared a report describing the averages over the last several years. He also went line by line to show prior year budget expenses and explained it to all those present. Annual Routine expenses average out to about \$42,000. In the last year it was \$41,649. See Harry's report for details.

As part of the budget discussion, we talked about some expenses anticipated in the budget year. Discussion included heating upgrades for the club house. (Dave Isaac estimates between 5 and 6K. There are more efficient systems out there, but we don't often heat the clubhouse more than twice per month).

Remove some trees; including the one over the chalet.

Replace the roof on the chalet (this is a potential project and not immediate need).

Harry yielded the floor back to Nick and requested a budget vote at the end of the meeting. That gave members a chance to look through his reports and comment on other upcoming expenses.

Committee reports

Membership: Ron Breslawski— One member has turned in his membership. No other news. Dues notices have been mailed out.

Bldg and Grounds – Frank Petricone - Frank would like to focus on the field captain position and spend less time on buildings and grounds. He will leave future reports on each range to the various range directors. The last page of the monthly News Notes contains a list of all the range coordinators. Please call the appropriate coordinator or officer if you have issues.

Shady Range – Frank asked members to please do not staple paper targets to the rubber backers.

10 – stand - Frank P – It's OK to use the 10 stand but don't use the second tier which is still waiting on repairs. Dave and Frank are working on that.

Sporting clays – Frank P. - New machines for sporting clays should be delivered in a few weeks. Frank will broadcast their arrival and we need to pull the old machines off and build housings over the new ones. There will be scheduled times to make the transition and learn how to run the new machines/remotes.

Preserve – Dave Isaac – The preserve ran from September 3 until March 24th. 376 birds released 265 birds taken. Thanks to all those who worked the grasses and fields for cover. It was a good year. Commitment with F&B for 300 birds next year. There was a bird flu that wiped out a lot of the regular suppliers for birds. Dave expressed thanks to all the club members that helped throughout the year.

Camp Rushford – Is full for the season. Other DEC camps cannot get staffing.

Monroe County Conservation Council – Chris Weist – Legislators on break for Easter, no state budget yet so no activity on gun/hunting legislation. Conservation council is having a fishing derby for kids on June 3, 2023. The flyer is posted in the club house.

Club calendar – June 10th or 17th, Flag Day / Gary Beikirch VOC shoot? Nick had a lot of people ask about the next shoot in our calendar and it would be October. Should we do a flag day shoot? Frank suggested a Memorial Day weekend shoot. Discussion held about the best weekend to shoot. There seemed to be interest in having another shoot but could not agree on the best weekend. After much discussion the group decided on a June 10th open shoot. Advertising to follow. Do we want to donate to the VOC? Can we get permission to use the Gary Beikirch name? We should reach out to the Beikirch family. Mike K has contacts at the VOC so he and Nick will do some of the background work to make this happen.

New Business -

Skills survey – Please complete the skills survey and return it. Mail it to the club or email it to Nick. It's on the website under work opportunities.

Access lock for kitchen – In case the electronic card reader fails, there will be a mechanical lock installed on the kitchen door. Club officers will have a key.

Guest protocol and payment – If you bring guests, educate them. As the member, make sure your guests leave before you do. Make sure your guests are paying – or you pay for – their targets Make sure your guests are completing the waiver. Each guest only needs to complete it once.

Please make sure the club house door closes and locks behind you.

Vote held on the budget. Dan Spencer asked for \$1000 for the archery range. Discussion held regarding \$2 daily fee for shooting on the archery range. Motion to approve, 2nd, approved by vote. No one recorded as opposed.

Secretary's Report – Dan Carlson News Notes published after BoD meeting.

Treasurer's Report – Harry Reiter – Income so far in April: 421.45 Expenses: 983.76 big expenses accumulated grounds and admin costs of \$626 for dumpster, trash bags, exit door lock, etc. See Harry's report for further. Motion to accept was made, 2nd, and passed by vote.

Membership Report – Ron Breslawski – Rich Iuppa Thomas Eadie, and Mike Roffe applied for life membership (Nick will follow up for the appropriate paperwork), motion made and 2nd to accept them all, passed by vote. Nick Hardie reported that he had received two other life member applications. Rifle Range Tom Sime & Mike K. – Proposal for upgrades has been prepared. See new business below.

Shady Range – Clayton Eckerd – no report.

Preserve – Dave Isaac (not present but had sent a report to Nick) – "100% complete and shut down until September. It was a great year."

Old Business -

Tree removal proposals – Tim Daily got two quotes \$6000. J&T (\$6000) on Drake Rd. and J&M \$8640. Both quotes for two trees over the chalet (put down on the ground), two maples between the club house and barn (down and gone completely), and three trees along the driveway (down on the ground). Tom Sime will ask a contact that he has and get back to us.

New Business -

Flag Day Shoot - June 10th - Nick H. – Flyers are being completed. Serving food, (burgers and sausage) Nick has contacted the VOC. They will work with us.

Carpenter's Shoot September 16th - Need someone to be the director for that day. Neither Nick nor Ron B. will be here that day. Frank P. to take care of the course. Dave S. heard back from Tim. They are advertising and getting sponsors and sign ups out. They are lining up a caterer, too. Making progress.

Road work – Mike K and Frank P did the driveway – Thank you!!

Left over tree stands – Nick H. they have been taken down and set in the barn. One from the NW corner of the corn field by the creek and two with climbing sticks. If they have not been claimed, they will be raffled off at the June shoot. If you have an issue call Nick H. Rule 20 of the Club Ground Rules addresses removal of tree stands.

Upgrades for rifle range – Tom Sime and Mike K. – recommend a new roof and a range flag to indicate someone is down range. Also need to reinforce the wood bracings and move some dirt around. Tom was encouraged to get quotes for a new roof. It's 95' x 11.'

Hats – Tom also inquired about the logo for new hats. Nick gave Tom the ordering information from the last order.

Harry R. – recommends that we open a savings account or CD with some of the \$20,000 we have had in reserve for years and years. Should we buy a CD or get a savings account and start earning interest on our reserves? Should we get a couple of charge cards and make it easier for folks who spend money regularly? Board encouraged Harry to seek out good options for at least a savings or money market account. Board was generally pessimistic about the charge card idea and like the extra security of Harry approving the purchases.
