Membership Report – Ed Breslawski – Seven prospective new members were in attendance. – See Above. After everyone had a chance to introduce themselves, Nick made a motion to accept all en masse. Treasurer's Report – Harry Reiter – **Income: \$7464.74 Expenses: \$1993.73** New trailer for Polaris ATV \$975. Material to cover new traps \$719.57. See Harry's report for further. A motion was made to accept the report, 2nd, and approved by vote.

Buildings, Grounds, and Equipment – Tim Daily – was given a check for deposit (10% = \$600, JT's trees) for the tree removal between barn and clubhouse, across the driveway from Clubhouse and over the chalet.

Club Safety and Security – Outside lock for kitchen door installation date – Dave Scorse replaced the door and has keys to distribute.

Ranges:

Archery – Dan Spencer – working on options for replacing some targets.

Ten Stand – 10 Stand Bracing Completed!! Three estimates received for lumber from Al C. Board authorized Al to spend \$515 on lumber to replace the wood.

Skeet – Tim Daily's report – Has been working with Don Franklin with some issues with wiring caused by plugging in and unplugging the skeet traps. A new procedure is pending. For now, in the **low house:**

Keep trap plugged in, turn wall switch on, turn trap switch on. When shutting down, release trap, turn trap switch off, turn wall switch off.

Sporting Clays Course – progress on new traps. Trap covers are built and moved close to position. Frank has pulled the old Pro-Matic machines from the course. The new machines will be moved out there soon. Frank needs some help to move the new machines and covers into place. Monday or Wednesday of next week? Saturday 8am? Call Frank to give him a hand and learn how to use the new remotes.

Trap Range – Frank Petricone – The trap machine is working well and ready for use.

Rifle Range Tom Sime & Mike K. – Proposal for upgrade. Have received two quotes: \$7000 (Chris Miller) and \$4500 (Kevin Barker – which does not include replacing the plywood). Discussion was held regarding the need to replace the whole thing, replace the plywood, or perform spot maintenance. Al C. will inspect it more closely and report back. Al will have to close the range for an hour or so.

Shady Range – Clayton Eckerd – nothing to report.

Preserve – Dave Isaac – "100% complete and shut down until September. It was a great year."

Club Calendar – June 10 Flag Day VOC Shoot – plans coming together. Still need some help on the day of the shoot, contact Nick to help.

New Business -

September 16th - **Carpenters Shoot**; need point person: Dave Scorse will coordinate registration/club house, Frank will be Field Captain. Capped at 18 – 4 person teams. Food will be catered. Will need scorecards and plenty of club waivers. Will want to use the charcoal pit outside. Need to make sure we have charcoal and the metal on the grill replaced. Dave S. is working on it.

Flag Day Shoot June 10th. Flyers are going out. VOC has 144 flags to give us for the shoot. There are only 15 members signed up to work it (so far).

Boiler and heat runs – after Nick had discussion with Dave Isaac – which included a discussion of how many days we actually heat the club through the winter, it was determined that it is not cost effective to replace the boiler and heat runs now. This topic will be tabled.
