Treasurer's Report - Harry Reiter - January income \$3769.35, big income was the post-holiday shoot \$2990.75. Expenses \$4292.27. Big expenses were all part of club administration (\$2467.20) for property taxes, special use permit, and more. Harry also filed a Post Holiday shoot report. Net income (after expenses) from the shoot was \$1892.25. A motion to approve the reports was made, 2nd, and approved by vote.

Harry is working on the budget proposal for the next fiscal year. He solicited the members present if anyone has any major items that need to be purchased in the next fiscal year.

Dave Scorse mentioned a land plane – a box that you drag behind a tractor that grades the dirt driveway and fills in the holes. Bentley Brothers has one at approx. \$2600 plus tax. Due to the relative inexpense of the A motion was made to have Dave spend up to \$3000 to purchase the land plane.

New Business -

Al Castrechino asked if we would like to serve food at the shoots again. The discussion was tabled to the next board meeting when more members are present.

Dave Scores brought up tearing down the old rifle range and building a new one the height of the addition on the east end. He will gather a quote for the cost of materials for the project.

Ed Breslawski spoke to the Hamlin highway superintendent about potentially cleaning out the creek (especially where it goes under Walker Lake Ontario Rd). The short version is it is not possible because it deals with federal wetlands and a permit could be submitted for review by the Feds if there is a physical damn built, but nothing will be permitted for the removal of any single one tree down, no matter how many single trees lay across. This discussion occurred because our club's driveway floods with excessive snow melt or rain.

Jeff Butterman from Freedom Guide Dogs and his wife attended the meeting. The club used to donate proceeds from the hangover shoot to this organization back in the '90s. Duke Kimmel was the contact then. The Butterman's asked if it was something the club possibly would be interested in doing again. These guide dogs are given exclusively to veterans: free of charge. The price to raise a dog is approximately \$25,000. They're looking for anything at all to help. The Board will bring it up at the general meeting to see if it's something that the membership is interested in doing, or potentially even putting a donation jar at the shoot sign up at the St Patty's Day shoot. Possibly doing a 50/50 at the shoot for the benefit was another idea.
