Board of Directors Meeting August 15, 2024

Call to Order: 7:00 pm by Ron Breslawski.

Treasurer's Report - Harry Reiter – Reports submitted for both July and August as there was no general meeting in to approve the July report. Al C made a motion to accept both reports, motion 2nd by Frank P. Motion carried by vote.
