Call to Order – Ron Breslawski – 7:31pm

Secretary's Report – Dan Carlson – News Notes - available after BOD meeting. Al Castrechino made a motion to accept, 2nd by Dan Sperr, passed by vote.

Treasurer's Report - Harry Reiter - Hunter Tour shoot report

Report for September – Income \$9054.19. Big income items Hunter's Tour (see extra report) and preserve dues (\$3150.). Expenses \$11,103.86. Big expense items are from the administrative line (\$8979.54) and include School taxes (over \$6000), a new AED and S.C.O.P.E. dues.

Hunter's Tour treasurer report – 202 shooters participated. Total Income \$4,110. Total Expenses \$1,020. Harry clarified that he just received more invoices tonight so the final number will change. Motion to accept both reports was made by Ed Breslawski, 2nd by George Reese. Carried by vote.

Membership – Ed Breslawski – No new member activity but a new waiting list has been posted today.

Bldg and Grounds – Frank Petricone – new lights installed near the club and near the barn. A new light fixture has been installed in the club house. Call to Order: 7:10 pm by Ron Breslawski.

Secretary's Report – Dan Carlson - No updates from the board. Motion to approve the previous report was made and 2^{nd} . Report approved by vote.

Treasurer's Report - Harry Reiter – October income so far was \$2939.55. The biggest item was the sale of 3D targets (\$2000). October expenses so far, \$4812.06 and the biggest expense item was new pheasants for the preserve (\$2500). Harry also provided an updated report on the Hunter's Tour from September 28-29. The total income from the event was \$4110. Total expenses were \$1769. The net gain was \$2341. John Lyon made a motion to accept both reports, motion 2^{nd} by Frank P. Motion carried by vote.

Membership: Ed Breslawski –No new members and no life member requests.

A member attended the meeting and asked permission to switch positions on the waiting list. His daughter is next on the list and a close friend is several places down. A lengthy discussion was held and many senior members in attendance said this type of issue has come before and switching places on the list will NOT be approved. Several in attendance cited precedence. The member then asked if his daughter's name could be removed from the top of the list and placed at the bottom of the list to allow someone else to have the next opening. This was approved.

A related note to members from Ed Breslawski - If you know people – if you are the sponsor of someone - on the list and they move or change their contact information, they need to call the membership director to provide an update.

Buildings, Grounds, and Equipment – Clayton Eckerd – A couple of trees blew down across the road. Clayton and Frank cleaned it up. If you ever discover a problem on the grounds and you cannot address it, please call Clayton or Frank as soon as you can.

Frank P. - Please close the lid to the porta-john when you leave it. We don't want critters crawling in it.

Range Reports - Frank Petricone – DO NOT put already thrown clay birds and put them back in the machines! This applies to all ranges! The birds we use are biodegradable. We don't want them to compromise the rest of the birds in the carousel. It used to be our practice when we used hand thrown traps, but it should not be done with our automatic traps.

Archery – no updates.

10 stand - is operational

Skeet - Please shut down the skeet houses as per the written directions!

Sporting clays – please close the mailboxes completely! Rifle range – pick up your own trash. Take your targets down when you are done.

Shady range – Clayton took down the paper targets. The paper gets waterlogged and falls apart this time of year. There are plenty of targets in the shed. Help yourself but clean up. Put the staple gun away. One of our staplers walked away in the last few weeks. If you know where it is, please return it. Best to bring your own stapler.

Ron Breslawski – received a complaint a member. The member pulled into the club and a landscaper's vehicle and trailer were parked in our driveway so he could mow across the street. Our member talked to the landscaper, and he was told some member gave him permission. Ron surveyed the board, and no one gave permission. Ron will follow up with the landscape company.

Club Calendar – No big events currently on the calendar. Post-Holiday shoot 1/4/25.

Club Safety and Security – No updates.

Old Business -

Clayton E. has been doing research on first aid kits. He could spend thousands. What are the minimum requirements?
