Board of Directors Meeting January 16, 2025

Call to Order: N/A.

This meeting was cancelled in person due to several members of the Board not being able to attend. The discussion noted happened between January 7th and January 10th, 2025, via email. The Board members that participated in the discussion were Ed Breslawski, Ron Breslawski, Dan Carlson, Clayton Eckerd, John Lyon, Frank Petricone, Harry Reiter, and Dave Scorse.

Secretary's Report – Dan Carlson - No updates.

Treasurer's Report - Harry Reiter – Harry provided reports on the Post-Holiday Sporting Clays shoot and the midmonth of January. Post Holiday shoot: total income \$1786. Total expense was \$458. Net \$1328. Mid-month report total income \$2149. The big income was the post-holiday shoot with a total income of \$1786. Expenses so far were \$4594.23 with the biggest expense item being the payment of property taxes of \$4333.84. Frank P. made a motion to accept both reports. John L. 2nd the motion. No one wished to be listed as 'Nay.'

Buildings, Grounds, and Equipment – Frank P-A tree has fallen on station 8 of the sporting clays course. It was caught by another standing tree, but both will need to be addressed. The tractor easily generates enough RPMs to run the brush hog even though the tractor does not have a huge engine.
